If the order or agreement for support has been assigned to a person or agency, the assignee must be served with this form and the Change Information Form (Form 15A). The assignee's consent to change an order or agreement for support may be necessary. It is the responsibility of the person seeking the change to the order or agreement to determine if the order or agreement has been assigned. You can do this by submitting a Confirmation of Assignment form. The Confirmation of Assignment form is available through the Ministry of the Attorney General website or at the court office.

**IF YOU CONSENT TO THE CHANGES BEING SOUGHT IN THIS MOTION,** you or your lawyer must complete the Consent Motion to Change (Form 15C—a blank copy should be attached) and return a copy to the person(s) bringing the motion and any assignee, if applicable, within 30 days of being served (60 days if the motion to change is served on you outside Canada or the United States). The person(s) bringing the motion may then file the consent with the court and may obtain a court order based on the consent. If a first court date has been scheduled, you do not need to attend court on that date unless specifically directed by the court to do so.

**IF YOU WANT TO OPPOSE ANY CHANGE BEING SOUGHT IN THIS MOTION OR WANT TO REQUEST A CHANGE OF YOUR OWN,** you or your lawyer must complete the Response to Motion to Change (Form 15B—a blank copy should be attached), serve a copy on the person(s) bringing the motion and file a copy in the court office with an Affidavit of Service (Form 6B). **YOU HAVE ONLY 30 DAYS AFTER THIS MOTION TO CHANGE IS SERVED ON YOU (60 DAYS IF THE MOTION TO CHANGE IS SERVED ON YOU OUTSIDE CANADA OR THE UNITED STATES) TO SERVE AND FILE A RESPONSE TO A MOTION TO CHANGE. IF YOU DO NOT, THE CASE WILL GO AHEAD WITHOUT YOU AND THE COURT MAY MAKE AN ORDER AND ENFORCE IT AGAINST YOU.**

NOTE: If you want to make your own claim to change support, you **MUST** also fill out a Financial Statement (Form 13 or 13.1), serve a copy on the person(s) bringing the motion and file a copy in the court office with an Affidavit of Service (Form 6B) **UNLESS** your only claim for support is for child support in the table amount specified under the Child Support Guidelines.
